## **TERMS OF REFERENCE: APPEALS COMMITTEE**

## The Committee is responsible for:

- 1. Considering and deciding on whether individual appeals have established appropriate grounds for appeal according to the disciplinary, performance or grievance procedures.
- 2. To gather further evidence at appeal committee hearings and to decide, on the basis of that information, whether an appeal should be upheld or rejected.
- 3. To determine whether any appeal made by a member of staff under any of the Council's personnel policies are valid.
- 4. To hold appeal hearings under the Disciplinary, Grievance, Performance, Redundancy and Redeployment processes with a view to
- 5. To determine the appeal under the appropriate procedure. (NB. Any Councillor who has previously been involved in the process prior to the appeal may not sit on the Appeal hearing.)
- 6. Only the Council may endorse a decision to dismiss the Community Council Clerk
- 7. To determine any appeals under the Council's Complaint Procedure which is delegated to it.
