The payment to St Brides Major Nursery will allow the playgroup to remain open until the end of the 2023-24 school year so that the children can transition to alternative care provision.

## 9. Rivermouth Car Park.

Emma Reed of the Vale of Glamorgan Council was able to provide an update on the Barrier/ANPR installation at Rivermouth Car Park:

Mrs Reed began by acknowledging that the scheme had not been a success up to now and that lessons learned in Ogmore had been useful in the installation of similar projects in Barry and elsewhere.

The technology requires updating by the supplier so that the intercom system is operational. When working the intercom will be operated by Cardiff Council along with a number of other Vale car parks. Emma Reed was hopeful that the intercom would be operational by the May Bank Holidays and this would help to reduce anti-social behaviour in the car park. Residents were encouraged to continue reporting incidents of anti-social behaviour to the police via 101.

The charges for car parking are changing in April to a two hour interval rate, it is hoped this will result in fewer people seeking to avoid payment.

There is a proposal to introduce charges for residents parking permits, this is likely to go before the Vale cabinet in May. The public are welcome to attend the meeting. The level of charge has not yet been determined.

It is the Vale of Glamorgan's intention to submit a section 38 application to the Welsh Government in order to improve the car parking situation in the Portobello and Norton Hill area. The Vale are in correspondence on this issue with the landowner (Dunraven Estate).

**Action:** the Community Council to request a timetable for the installation of the intercom system.

**Action:** reconvene meetings of the Task and Finish Group.

The Chair thanked Emma Reed for her attendance.
